# An Old Time Radio Christmas II

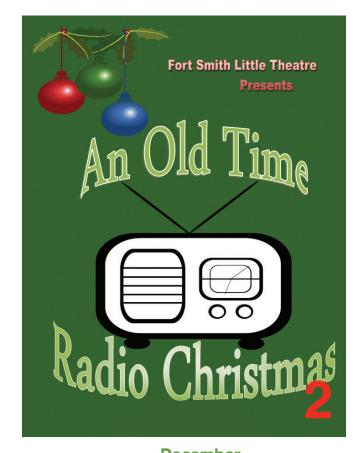
