EXCITING NEWS -ONLINE TICKETING IN 2019

We are pleased to announce that online ticketing will be implemented for our 2019 season.

- Season Flex Pass Patrons will be able to use their designated pass code to select their seats online, or call our box office to leave a message regarding their seating request. As always, they will have 5 days to select their seats before tickets are sold to the public.
- Those without a Season Pass (the **General Public**) can buy tickets online beginning one week before each production opens, or call the box office and purchase their tickets on the phone with one of our volunteers.
- Gala Opening Night Subscription Patrons may use online ticketing to select their seats for the entire year when they purchase their subscription package. Alternately, our box office will perform the 6-show seat selection for them.

This is a big step forward for FSLT. More information will be provided before the 2019 season begins.
