Director Valerie Baldwin Valentine is planning to give Fort Smith Little Theatre patrons plenty to talk about when she brings Neil Simon's *Rumors* to the stage next month. "For those who are not familiar with Neil Simon, you can expect to laugh ... a lot," Valentine said of the upcoming production which will be staged November 12-22.

In the play, four couples gather to celebrate the 10th wedding anniversary of their dear friends, Charley and Myra Brock. Charley happens to be the deputy mayor of New York. Unfortunately, the party never gets hopping due to the little problem of the host shooting himself and his wife disappearing. Confusion and hilarity ensue as the friends try to cover things up, deal with rumors, and keep things under control. "I love this show because it is such a wonderfully written script," Valentine said. "The humor is clever; it is a mix of physical and verbal comedy. I also love it because it is just as fun for the actors to play the characters as it is for the audience to watch."

Arriving first at the scene is Ken (Ben Baldwin) and Chris Gorman (Tina Dale), both lawyers. As Charley Brock's attorney, Ken tries to keep the shooting under wraps with the help of Lenny Ganz (Ian Miller), Charley's accountant, and his wife, Claire (Summer Ferguson). Rounding out the octet is Ernie (Matt Ortega) and Cookie Cusack (Jill Ledbetter), a psychiatrist and a cooking show
