Romantic Comedy with a Familiar Story Opens at FSLT

"She had a love after all she told me. A secret love. And she threw him right in my face!" "Who?" "Me!"

Veteran FSLT actress, Jamie Lambdin-Bolin, makes her full-season directorial debut with Parfumerie, a heartwarming romantic comedy. Being performed on the FSLT stage November 11-20, the play was adapted by E.P. Dowdall from the original Hungarian play *Illatszertár*.

While Parfumerie may have an unfamiliar name, the play has been the inspiration for three popular films. Illatszertár by Miklos Laszlo was written in 1937, and was the basis for the Jimmy Stewart and Margaret Sullivan 1940 classic film Shop Around the Corner. Later the script was adapted as the 1949 movie musical In the Good Old Summertime starring Judy Garland and Van Johnson. Most recently the script inspired the 1998 rom-com You've Got Mail starring Tom Hanks and Meg Ryan, as well as the stage musical She Loves Me.

The story involves Mr. Miklos Hammerschmidt (Jon Gustafson) who owns a shop selling perfume, soaps, and lotions in 1937 Hungary. Loyal employee George Horvath (John Hall) works hard in the shop and takes solace in his romantic pen pal relationship with a young woman. But will the romance survive when George learns that his beloved mystery woman is actually Amalia Balash (Emilee Dale), the prickly co-worker he bickers with day in and day out?

Complicating the action are a colorful cast of characters including slippery sales clerk Steven Kadar (Eric Wells), glamour girl Ilona Ritter (Ashleigh Mathews), aging clerk Mr. Sipos (Gary

Director Lambdin-Bolin is supported by an expert crew. Rikkee Black serves as assistant director, while Melissa Vitale and Erik Krigbaum share producing duties. Brandon Bolin is stage manager, Scott Black is set designer, and Rusty Peoples and Gary Cameron will be part of the set crew. Jorgi Anderson and Audra Sargent are in charge of props, while Tina Dale is in charge of costumes. Jorgi Anderson also serves as light technician, while Aaron Ray is the graphic designer in charge of show art.

Like many FSLT productions, *Parfumerie* is a family affair. Director Lambdin-Bolin has selected her husband Brandon Bolin to serve as stage manager. Assistant Director Rikkee Black and set designer Scott Black met and married at FSLT. Other family units participating include married couple Gary and Sharla Cameron, father and daughter Wayne and Ashleigh Mathews, mother and daughter Tina and Emilee Dale, and mother and son Denay Burris and Joseph McAdoo.

Emilee Dale says her love for *You've Got Mail* drew her to audition. "I loved the role of Amalia when I looked into the *Parfumerie* script." Her mother, costume mistress Tina

Dale, is attracted to the time period. "Hats!" she exclaimed. "I really wanted to see what we could do to incorporate hats into the wardrobe. And this era of fashion is my absolute favorite."

While the cast includes FSLT veterans, there are new faces as well. Malcolm Matlock is making his FSLT debut as Arpad. "The small stage space really ignites the chemistry between performers. I love these people, and I'm really thankful to be a part of this show."

Director Lambdin-Bolin says that the romantic story reminds her of her own courtship. "The love/hate relationship George and Amalia share reminds me of how my husband and I behaved toward each other when we first met. Working on this production with him has brought back many fond memories and made many more."
