And then there is Bud Davis – Bud, the Stud – the very amorous neighbor, who ensures to keep the female guests at Rose Cottage thoroughly entertained (and some more)... Add to the mix, Victoria (a romance novelist), Charmaine (a southern belle), & Hillary (Henry’s friend and a scientific guinea pig) – what we have is a full blown adult comedy with hot flashes, mood swings, tears, and tons to laugh about...

Cast Biographies

- **Harold MacDowell** (playing Bud Davis): Being in this play (the first since high school) has been a wonderful “Renewing” experience and enables me to check this off my bucket list.
- **Angela Covey** (playing Mrs. Stancliffe): I first trod the boards at FSLT in 1975 - in the 35 years since then, I have had the opportunity to be many different characters. I have directed eight plays and made many many friends. But now I want you all to sit back and enjoy your stay at my Bed-&-Breakfast.
- **Richard Van Wagoner** (playing Henry Mitchell): - AKA “the iceman” - You will enjoy all the subtle banter between cast members here and know that “I don’t do well with crying women”. Henry is reserved, reliable, straight-laced, and true to his convictions - a retired Chemist working on a pill called Venusia - “You’re not? Really? At your age?”...
- **Mary Beth Koprovic** (playing Victoria Ambrose): She writes romantic novels but really wants to be the leading lady in her books - really willing and able to fill the role. The Theatre Family keeps me coming back, and now there is “Bud the Stud” in the throes of FSLT.
- **Nicolette Sutfin** (playing Hillary Hudson): I am both grateful and astonished to find myself not in the audience but on stage for the first time with FSLT’s most capable actors and directors. Long past chorus work led to the role of Reno Sweeney in a Farmington Players Production (MI) of Anything Goes - my only roles of late have been as a wife, a mother, and community volunteer. Well, “if you saw this on stage, you wouldn’t believe it”.
