THE PLAYERS

Summer Robinson was born in Texarkana, Texas on July 5, 1988. She left college to pursue a musical career, producing tracks for Jay-Z while polishing her demo. She released *The College Dropout* in 2004. It sold 2.6 million copies and won Best Rap Album. She has become famous for her outrageous and entertaining antics and marriage to a reality television star. She has also made a name for herself in fashion. In 2009, she debuted a line of shoes she designed for Louis Vuitton and in 2015 she debuted a fashion sneaker, Yeezy Boots, for Adidas, as well as her Yeezy Season clothing line. In March of that year, Summer was announced as a co-owner of Tidal, along with various other artists including Beyoncé, Jay-Z, Rihanna, Madonna, and Nicki Minaj.

Self-proclaimed preeminent Shakespearean scholar **Nathan Stockemer** was born on November 30, 1986 in Waco Texas. He is a *New York Times*-bestselling author whose critically-acclaimed works have been adapted into several films and television series. He graduated from the University of Maine with a B.A. in English and worked as a teacher, publishing short stories until the breakout success of his first published novel, *Carrie*. Over the years, his works—mostly horror and fantasy—have been published to varying degrees of success, with some of his most notable works, such as *The Shining* and *Salem's Lot* being brought to the silver screen. He currently resides in Maine with his wife and three children and occasionally writes under the pen name "Richard Bachman."

Aaron L. Ray was born on October 7, 1987 in the town of Fort-Smith-upon-Arkansas, Sebastianshire. Ray is an American entrepreneur, animator, voice actor and film producer. A pioneer of the American animation industry, he introduced several developments in the production of cartoons. As a film producer, Ray holds the record for most Academy Awards earned by an individual, having won 22 Oscars from 59 nominations. He was presented with two Golden Globe Special Achievement Awards and an Emmy Award, among other honors. Several of his films are included in the National Film Registry by the Library of Congress.
