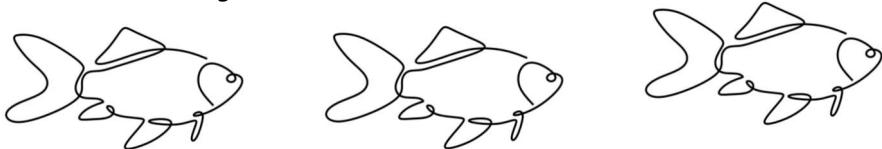

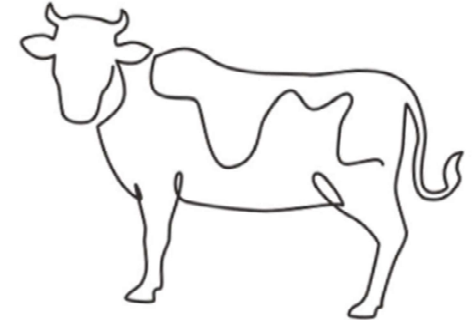
Director's Note:

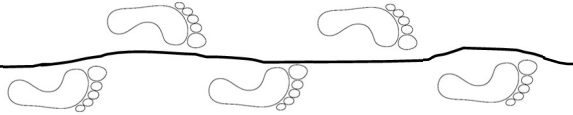

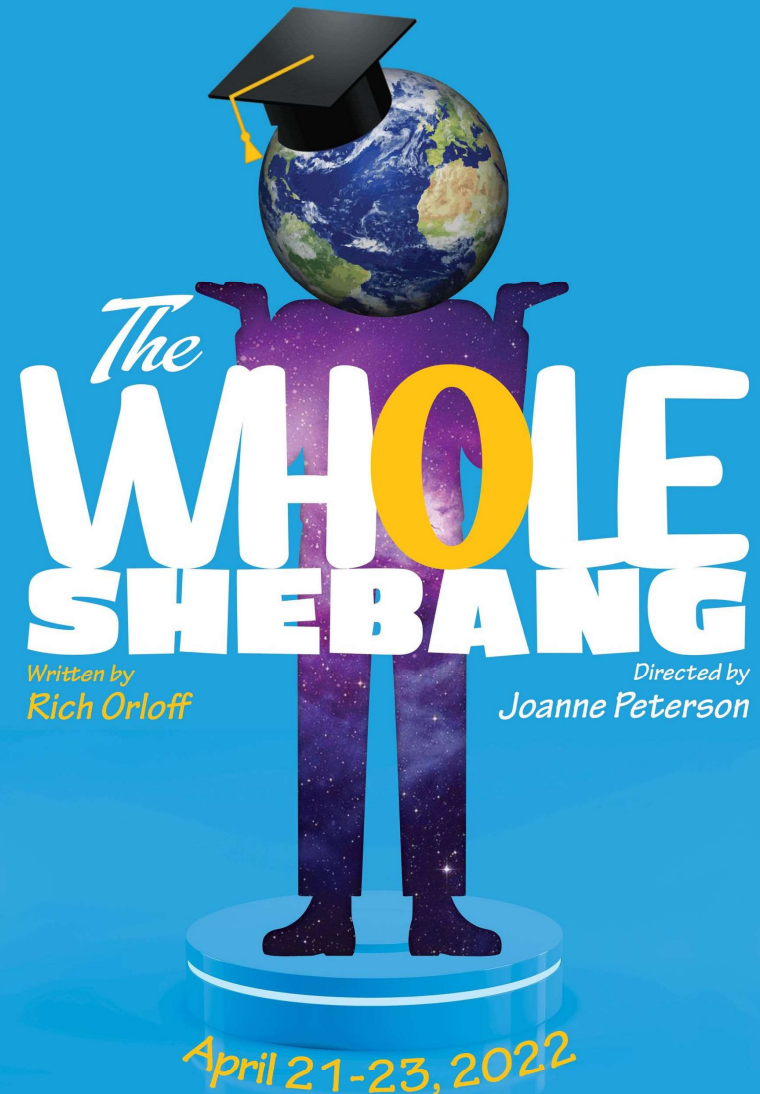
