Meet the Cast

SCOTT BLACK (Fred Narracott) grew up both backstage and onstage at FSLT. His most recent appearances have been as William H. Gallagher in *Light Up the Sky* (2024) and as A.C. Peterson in *The Outsider* (2024).

BRANDON BOLIN (William Blore) is a frequent performer in both musicals and straight plays. His notable performances include Mr. Collins in *Pride and Prejudice*, Barnett Lloyd in *Crimes of the Heart*, Don Lockwood in *Singing in the Rain*, and Daddy Warbucks in *Annie*.

JUSTIN CIALONE (Anthony Marston) is making his FSLT debut as the amoral rich playboy Marston. We hope he will be back!
