The political comedy, *The Outsider*, written by Paul Slade Smith, opens November 14 at FSLT. Directed by veteran FSLT volunteer Tina Dale, this good natured, non-partisan farce revolves around a scandal in the governor's office of an unnamed state.

The Outsider is an award-winning play that has had more than 150 productions. Most recently the show won two 2023 Helen Hayes Awards.

The hilarity revolves around Ned Newley (Brett Short), the tongue-tied lieutenant governor of a small state who has a serious problem. The governor's affair with the runner up of a beauty pageant has led to his resignation and the resignations of all gubernatorial staff leaving Ned with a sudden and unwanted promotion.

Ned's loyal Chief of Staff Dave Riley (Ian Miller) is doing his best to help Ned recover from his disastrous televised swearing in ceremony. Ned seems destined to fail, so Dave calls in Paige Caldwell (Janelle Cox), the kind of hard-core professional pollster and television surrogate we see on the news every night.

Ned and Dave are soon joined by famous political operative Arthur Vance (John Hall) who holds court on the national cable news programs. Ned also has a secret weapon – the inept but supremely confident temp Louise Peakes or "Lulu" (Joanne Peterson) whose innate political talent sweeps her up into unthought of heights.



The test of the new political team comes with the arrival of beautiful and ambitious tv reporter Rachel Patterson (Nicole Bostick) and her near silent but all-seeing cameraman A.C. Peterson (Scott Black). When these personalities collide, the political shenanigans begin!

Director Tina Dale has recruited an experienced crew to keep backstage running smoothly. Lexi Housley serves as assistant director and Joe Graham is the producer. Michael Fox is the stage manager and Gary Cameron is the set builder. Dolores Chitwood is in charge of costuming. Additional crew members include Rikkee Black, Sharla Cameron, and Aslyn Cox.

Dale says, "I submitted this show for November of this season because I thought it would be timely. Little did I know just how much we would all need a good laugh after this wildly political and partisan election year. *The Outsider* is a comedy that pokes lighthearted fun at politics while celebrating democracy – and it gives us the chance to step back and see just how absurd our political processes can sometimes be. Regardless of their political affiliations, I know our audiences will all appreciate the excellent comic writing of The Outsider.

Experienced actor Brett Short is excited to bring the newly promoted governor to life: "Governor Ned Newley is very capable at government, but when it comes to speaking on television, or to people for that matter,



he has a complete lack of confidence. He is a genuinely good guy who cares deeply about helping people through his position as governor. The subtleties of bringing a character like Ned to life on stage make for a complex set of challenges. His genuineness paired with his simple, yet funny approach to things, makes for an exciting role for me as an actor."

Actress Joanne Peterson, who returns to centerstage after a year-long break, is thrilled to perform as the hilarious character Lulu. "She is confident in everything she does, but clueless as to how things work. So, bringing her to life without turning her into a caricature will be the challenge. Lulu is also very positive and encouraging. The way she approaches things can be quite humorous, and that will be a joy for me in this role."

Performances are scheduled at 7:30 pm November 14-16 and 20-23. There will be a 2 pm matinee on Sunday November 17. Tickets for opening night are \$20 while all other performances are \$13. Seat selection for Flex Pass patrons begins at 7:00 am Saturday, November 2. Tickets go on sale to the general public beginning at 7 a.m. Thursday, November 7.
